Some Missouri communities are disproportionately affected by teen pregnancies & births.

For example, a teen in Normandy is 10 times more likely to experience a teen pregnancy than a teen in St. Charles, only 15 miles away.

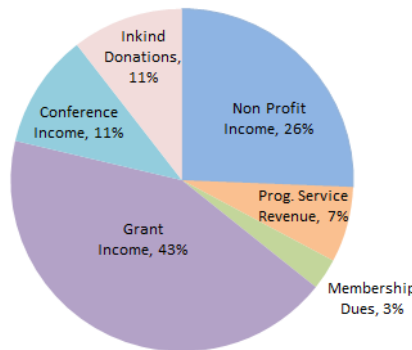
For reasons such as these, TPPP is dedicated to advocating for medically accurate sexual health education for ALL MISSOURI TEENS.

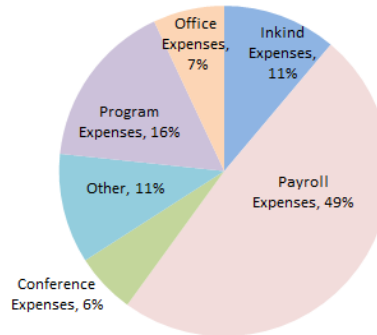
With your help in 2013, TPPP was able to continue its mission to improve and advocate for evidence-based, medically accurate sexual health education.

TPPP hosted 6 **Professional Development** meetings.

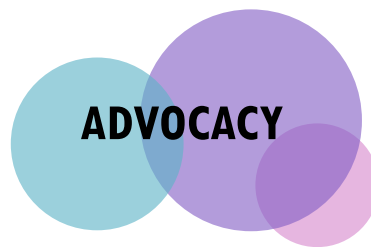
TPPP's **Conference** featured national keynote and statewide breakout speakers.

TPPP hosted **Sexual Health 101** in Columbia, MO for over **60 adults from around the state**.



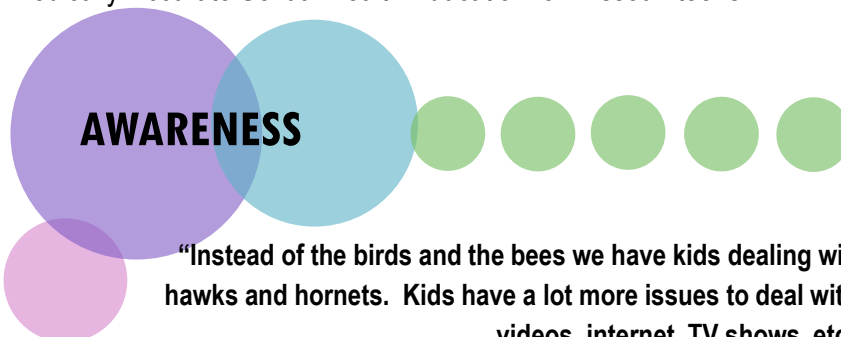

In 2013, TPPP worked legislatively to continue the conversation surrounding medically accurate sexual health education in Missouri. TPPP's Executive Director spoke in support of the LGBT nondiscrimination policy at the St. Louis County Council meeting and TPPP staff educated 66 legislators at the 2013 Legislative Breakfast in Jefferson City in partnership with Faith Aloud and the Missouri Family Health Council.

TPPP launched its first statewide community effort, **MASHE for MO**, to engage communities and school districts to advocate for **Medically Accurate Sexual Health Education** for Missouri teens.

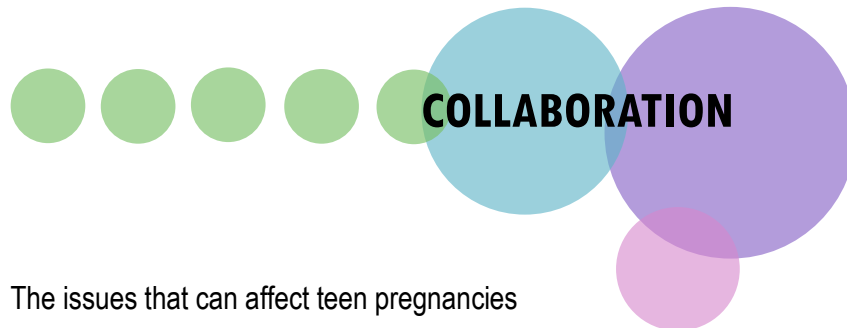
