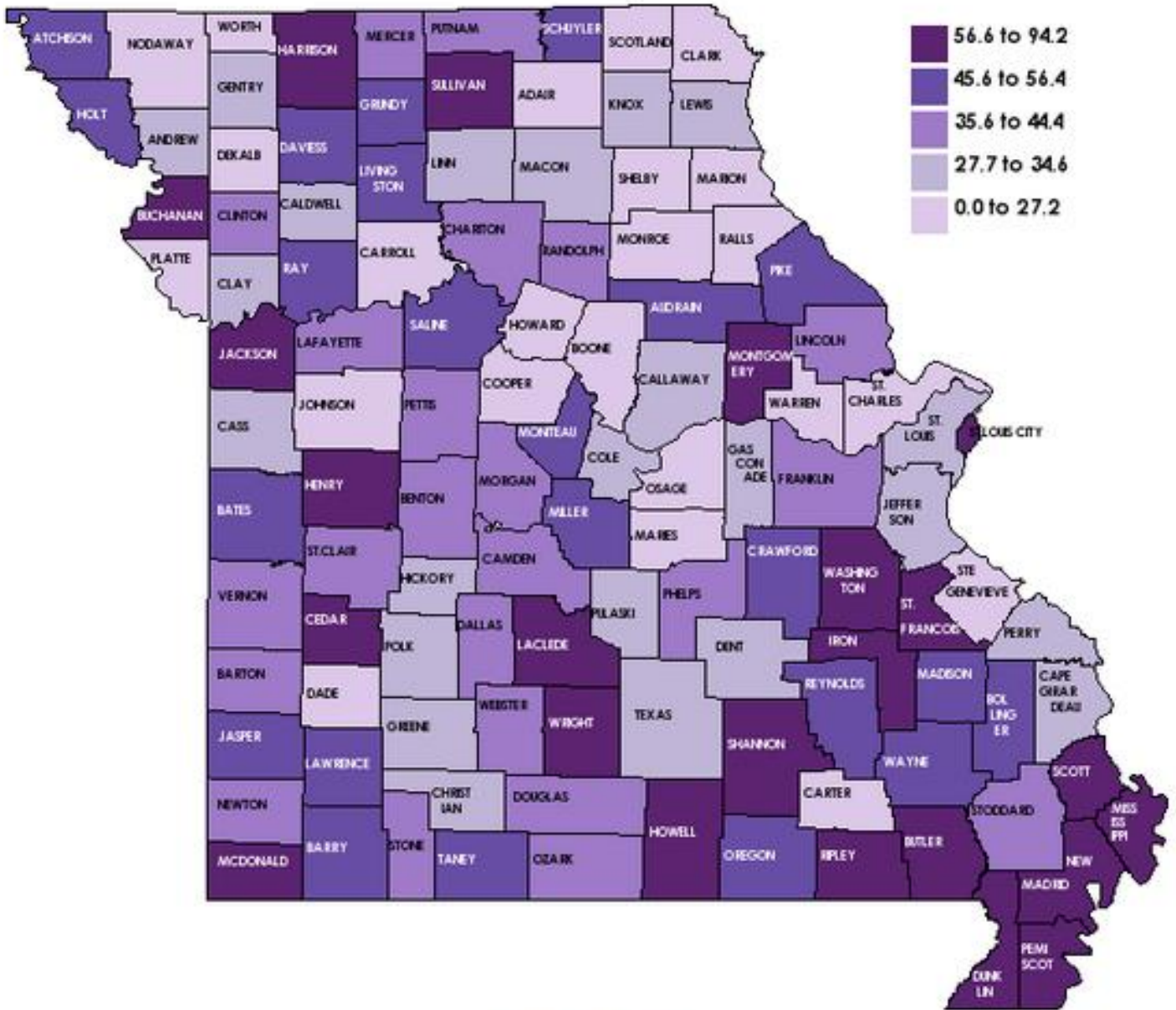


2012 Teen Pregnancy Rate for 15-19 Year Olds by Missouri County
